



WHAT IS VIET NAM FACING?



Climate change

- Vietnam is one of six economies most affected by climate change between 1999 and 2018.
- Within this period, Vietnam suffered 226 extreme weather events and saw economic losses of over US\$2 billion per year.
- The Mekong River delta is one of the largest deltas-17 million people and supplying more than half of Vietnam's rice production
- It is projected that about 30% area of the Mekong River Delta, is experiencing an unprecedented increase in salt intrusion, resulting from a 30-cm sea level rise.
- The average altitude of the delta is only about 80 cm above present sea level >< Projections of future sea-level rise for the end of the century range between +24 cm to +84 cm



VIETNAM'S EFFORTS AND GOALS TO 2030, VISION TO 2050

Net zero emissions by 2050

Ending deforestation

Reducing methane gas emissions by 2030

Scaled up solar energy capacity from almost zero in 2017 to more than 16,000 MW in 2022

Reduce marine plastic litter by 75% by 2030

By 2030, 100% of organic waste in urban areas and 70% of organic waste in rural areas will be recycled.

Protected marine and coastal areas to 3-5% of the total sea area

Forest coverage is expected to be sustained at 42-43% and at least 20% of the degraded ecosystem area

Increasing the area of protected ecosystems to 9% of the country's land area

Climate change related policies issued in 2022

"In 2022, Vietnam focused on developing policies mechanisms to implement the commitments: Decree 06 regulating GHGs emission reduction and ozone layer protection: including Article 91 on mitigation of GHGs emissions, Article 92 on ozone layer protection, Article 139 on carbon market development and organization.

- Decision No.01/2022/QĐ-TTg Promulgating the lists of sectors and establishments emitting GHGs subject to GHGs inventory;
- Decision No. 148-QD-TTg Approving a National System of Monitoring and Evaluation of Climate Change Adaptation Activities:
- Decision No. 888/QD-TTg Approving the Scheme on tasks and solutions to implement the outcomes of the COP26;
- Decision No.896/QĐ-TTg Promulgating the climate change strategy for the period up to 2050.

- Decision No. 942/QD-TTg: Viet Nam Action Plan for Methane Emissions Reduction by 2030 (reduce overall emissions by at least 30% below 2020 levels by 2030);
- Review and update NDC 2022, taking into account Vietnam's Net Zero commitment and some other related documents;
- Circular No. 17/2022/TT-BTNMT stipulating techniques for measurement, report and assessment of mitigation for GHGs emissions and GHGs inventory in the waste management sector.

- The roadmap for a MONRE Scheme: the commencement of a carbon credit exchange piloting by 2025 - official operation by 2028.
